Excerpt from Educational Hygiene The first striking fact is the relative neglect of physical standards for teachers. Less than one-third require a health certificate for entrance; less than one-half require a medical (or physical) examination at any time; just one-sixth require a health certificate for graduation. It may be noted in passing that the health certificate required is rather a certificate of freedom from disease than a certificate of rigorous health. Two important omissions will be noted: The time devoted to physical education and the kind of instruction in health habits and health knowledge. The encouraging things in this report are the number requiring physical exercise of all students, the emphasis upon games, both in required exercise and in practice teaching, and the number having gymnasiums. There is a distinct gain in these respects in the last 10 years. From these returns and from other inquiries, studies, and observations two important generalizations may be made: 1. In a few normal schools a broad and true conception of physical education prevails. It is recognized as organic and general,...
